**RESOLUTION DONATING RENO ACCESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FUNDS TO THE NEVADA CENTER FOR EXCELLENCE IN DISABILITIES TO DEFRAY EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH I CAN BIKE CAMP TO BE HELD JUNE 17-21, 2024 FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,800 (GENERAL FUND).**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to NRS 268.028, the City of Reno may donate funds to a charitable or educational entity to be expended for a selected purpose that substantially benefits inhabitants of the City of Reno; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Nevada Center for Excellence in Disabilities is a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization requesting funds to defray expenses associated with hosting a how to ride camp for persons with disabilities; and,

**WHEREAS**, on March 26,2024, the Reno Access Advisory Committee (RAAC) unanimously recommended City Council approve a \$4,800 donation to defray expenses associated with hosting I Can Bike Camp; and,

**WHEREAS**, riding a bike has many physical and mental health benefits for persons with disabilities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the requested donation will substantially benefit the residents of the City of Reno by providing increased access to cycling;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno desires to donate the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800) to the Nevada Center for Excellence in Disabilities, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, to defray expenses associated with I Can Bike Camp;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the donation of the sum of \$4,800 to defray expenses associated with I Can Bike Camp;
