

RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO ARTOWN IN SUPPORT OF THEIR MISSION TO STRENGTHEN RENO'S ARTS INDUSTRY, ENHANCE OUR CIVIC IDENTITY AND NATIONAL IMAGE, THEREBY CREATING A CLIMATE FOR THE CULTURAL AND ECONOMIC REBIRTH OF OUR REGION FROM VICE MAYOR TAYLOR (\$1,000) AND COUNCILMEMBER MARTINEZ (\$4,000) IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$5,000. (GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Artown's primary goal is to encourage local artist and creative participation to highlight the finest multidisciplinary arts in Northern Nevada; and,

WHEREAS, Artown, is a month-long summer arts festival, features nearly 500 events produced by more than 100 organizations and businesses at over 130 locations city and countrywide; and,

WHEREAS, Artown focuses on events to continue to be expressions of regional, national, and international artistic excellence; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Vice Mayor Taylor (\$1,000) and Councilmember Martinez (\$4,000) in the total sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to Artown; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
