Hello Karl Hall and Jonathan Shipman,

I just received my first returned phone call back from your office regarding this case. I believe Suzanne with Victims Services was the person with whom I spoke.

She mentioned the technicality that delayed the case that was brought to your offices attention back in August. She mentioned that your office had been calling the officer (the name she mentioned I have had no contact with) as it was Albert #16005 that we worked with and Sargent Slusser at DOIA at the Reno PD who has been working with me. Either way she mentioned repeatedly that your office has been trying to contact some officer regarding this case weekly by phone and possibly email and that the officer has never responded and that is why the case is still held up. This is odd considering Slusser was the one that got the case referred back to your office in August. There was some other reason she gave as to why they never contacted me - along the lines of they wanted to hear from the officer first. So it is my understanding if the officer never called back nothing was going to be done a second time. Again this is unacceptable and I personally don't appreciate the mischaracterization of the Reno PD not following through when it is your office that has failed to move forward despite overwhelming evidence that a crime was committed. Suzanne also mentioned something was now being done, but I would like to remind you nothing would have been done had I not kept following up with your office. This is unacceptable.

To recap the property damage crime:

1. A video of Michael Hale in the act of destroying our property and admitting to "doing us a favor" was uploaded and provided as evidence on 3/27/23 within 1 hour of the crime being committed.
2. An arrest was made of the individual within 30 minutes of the crime being committed.
3. 3 witness statements were provided within an hour of the crime being committed.
4. A receipt for over 500\$ damage was provided later in the summer (July).

My question is what does it take for your office to press charges against this individual?

If your process is to never reach out to the victim then I want you to know you are doing the community of Reno a disservice if this is the end result.

It is important to note that this crime occurred in March of this year and the statute of limitation is one year. I am again contacting your office as I want to press charges and I am hoping we do so before time runs out on this case considering your office has already wasted 8 hours or more of my personal time making sure something is done and sifting through all the misinformation provided.

Hello Mr. Karl Hall,

My name is Adam Bradley and my wife and I own a home here in SW Reno. On March 27, 2023 my wife observed Michael Hale (sp?) ripping up our sprinkler system in front of our home. I was in the driveway working on my vehicle when my wife ran out the front door and asked me to begin video taping Hale causing property damage to our sprinkler system. I began recording Hale in the process of ripping up the sprinkler system and he admitted to "doing us a favor" before leaving the premises. My wife called the police while I pursued Hale on foot for 30 minutes while providing directions to the police to his whereabouts. Towards the end of the pursuit Hale ran into several local businesses and actually exited through the back window of a insurance office before being subdued and arrested by Reno PD.

Upon returning home on March 27, 2023 both my wife and I submitted written statements and uploaded the video to the Reno PD website. They then forwarded this to the courts (which one I don't know) and the matter was eventually handled by your office. Upon returning from work out of state in July I learned that your office claimed there was "no evidence" and dropped the case. Some gentleman with whom I spoke with at your office told me that the police officer involved in the case provided one of the "worst written statements" he had ever seen and that it doesn't surprise him your office dropped the case as it had "nothing to go on". This ended up being a falsehood as the police were relying on the uploaded video and two eyewitness statements provided by my wife and I as plenty of evidence to press charges in this case. Due to being misled by the gentleman I spoke with at your office (I don't remember his name) I was under the impression the Reno PD hadn't done there job which I have now learned isn't the case. It is your office that has handled the matter poorly. To put it mildly I am disgusted as a 23 year resident of this city that you can have property damage costing a homeowner 500\$ (or more), an arrest, video footage of the crime committed and two eyewitness statements and the city attorneys office is incapable of reaching out to the victim of the crime to make sure justice is served. Let alone reviewing the evidence in the case. Or even providing correct information regarding the case in a timely manner. Or of returning any phone calls or inquiries regarding the case. Or of ever taking the initiative of reaching out to the victim of the crime regarding their case. Your office has wasted nearly 8 hours of my time on back and forth phone calls with Reno PD and it is now December and to date nothing has been done by your office. This is unacceptable.

Upon returning from my out of state job again this month I reached out to Reno PD again to see what was going on with my case. Again they referred it to your office a second time in late June or early July. Again on some technicality your office did nothing. No one reached out to me nor did anyone even look at the evidence provided. Yesterday after talking to Reno PD a second time I was made aware of the fact that your office has repeatedly done this to other victims and that they have seen this unfortunately on a regular basis out of your office. I realized this happened to us regarding another instance of property damage within the last few years. As the trial date came closer it became apparent that the court didn't have the video footage I provided in that case either. After attaching the video footage a 3rd time (now directly to the court representative) the court said I wasn't required to testify as the footage sufficed as evidence. Again this saved me time, however I am disappointed that your office isn't reviewing evidence. This is unacceptable.

I would like to recap the issues I am bringing to your attention regarding this case:

1. Your office has wasted an unreasonable amount of my time in what should be a cut and dry case.
2. Your office hasn't reviewed the provided evidence.
3. Your office hasn't returned any of my phone calls.
4. Your office has mischaracterized the Reno PD as the responsible party for this situation and that they are incompetent. That is a false hood. It is your office that has been irresponsible and incompetent in the handling of this case.

I don't know what the statute of limitation is on this matter, but I am hoping after reaching out to you someone at your office will do something about this matter.
