

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
THE GIRL SCOUTS OF THE SIERRA NEVADA (GSSN), TROOP 508, TO
SUPPORT THE RAINBOW BRIDGE PROJECT FROM MAYOR
SCHIEVE (\$1,000), VICE MAYOR TAYLOR (\$500), COUNCILMEMBER
MARTINEZ (\$500), COUNCILMEMBER REESE (\$1,000), AND
COUNCILMEMBER DUERR (\$500) IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$3,500.

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Girl Scouts of the Sierra Nevada (GSSN) is a nonprofit organization that serves as a leading platform for girls to develop leadership skills, build confidence, and engage in service to their communities; and,

WHEREAS, Girl Scout Troop 508, under the guidance of GSSN, has undertaken a community service initiative known as the **Rainbow Bridge Project**, aimed at building an inclusive community space to honor transitions, memories, and connections among pets and their owners”; and,

WHEREAS, the Rainbow Bridge Project demonstrates the core values of the Girl Scout movement — including leadership, compassion, environmental stewardship, and public service — and reflects positively on the youth of Reno; and,

WHEREAS, the GSSN and Troop 508 have requested community support to help bring this project to completion, and the City Council wishes to support and encourage youth-led efforts that enhance public spaces and community well-being; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donations from Mayor Schieve (\$1,000), Vice Mayor Taylor (\$500), Councilmember Martinez (\$500), Councilmember Reese (\$1,000) and Councilmember Duerr (\$500) in the total sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500) to the GSSN Troop 508; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
