Summary:

There are currently two vacancies on the Reno Access Advisory Committee (RAAC). The Clerk's Office has received applications from Jim Milligan.

The RAAC met on March 26, 2024, and recommended the appointment of Jim Milligan.

The term for appointment will be from May 1, 2024, through April 30, 2027.

Background:

The RAAC consists of nine members and shall include disabled persons and persons interested in issues involving disabled individuals. Committee members are to be appointed by Council. The term of membership is three years and members shall not serve more than two terms. Pursuant to Reno Municipal Code (RMC) 2.08.880, the RAAC may submit a list of potential members to Council for appointment to fill a vacancy. Appointments to vacancies other than the expiration of a term shall be for the remainder of the term and filled within 30 days of the vacancy.
