

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO  
SOULFUL SEEDS IN SUPPORT OF GROWING CONNECTION AND  
RESILIENCY THROUGH NEIGHBORHOOD GARDENS FROM VICE  
MAYOR TAYLOR (\$2,000) AND COUNCILMEMBER ANDERSON  
(\$3,500) IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$5,500. (GENERAL FUND)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, Soulful Seeds' vision is to cultivate a thriving community where everyone is welcome; and

**WHEREAS**, Soulful Seeds is a social and environmental, grassroots non-profit dedicated to reducing food insecurity by developing and managing urban gardens; and

**WHEREAS**, Soulful Seeds grows neighborhood gardens through community partnerships to create opportunity for people to learn, grow, and flourish; and

**WHEREAS**, Soulful Seeds participants act with respect and dignity and cultivate partnerships in the community; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the Council donations from Vice Mayor Taylor (\$2,000) and Councilmember Anderson (\$3,500) in the total sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500) to Soulful Seeds; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
