

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF NORTHERN NEVADA IN SUPPORT OF
THEIR MISSION TO RESPOND TO UNMET HUMAN NEEDS SO ALL
CAN THRIVE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing support to individuals and families in need within the Reno/Sparks community, addressing root causes of poverty and promoting economic equality; and,

WHEREAS, Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada operates with the mission to respond to unmet human needs, offering services such as food resources, case management, residential programs, and other essential resources to over 25,000 individuals on a monthly basis; and,

WHEREAS, Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada has a history of over 80 years of service to the community, affiliated with the Diocese of Reno but operating as a separately-incorporated 501(c)3 nonprofit agency; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the vital role played by Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada in bringing hope, spirit, and self-reliance to those in need within our community; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to support the efforts of Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada in addressing the root causes of poverty and helping individuals achieve a meaningful and purposeful life; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Duerr in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
