Background:

The City of Reno Parks and Recreation Department operates year-round health and fitness

programming at many of its facilities. The growth of programming within the department has been fed by the new RecConnect membership program. This has been the push to expand programming options and offer more to the members of the community. The yoga program within the department has grown with the addition of more classes within the recreation centers and at Moana Springs Community Aquatics and Fitness Center. The donation will allow for high quality yoga mats to be used at these sites in order to show investment into the programs hosted by the City of Reno.

Discussion:

GiveNKind would like to donate \$22,948 of product including yoga mats and balance cushions in support of the yoga programming through the City of Reno Parks and Recreation Department.
