

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
FUTURE KIND IN SUPPORT OF THE OFFBEAT 2024 FESTIVAL IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Reno City Council has recognized Arts, Parks, and Historical Resources as a strategic priority, acknowledging the significant role of arts and cultural events in fostering a vibrant and inclusive community; and,

WHEREAS, In Kind is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to inspiring sustainable community development through diverse collaboration and creating equitable opportunities; and,

WHEREAS, the 2024 Off Beat Festival, organized in part by In Kind, is a celebrated event that showcases local and regional artists, musicians, and cultural performances, contributing to the enrichment of Reno's arts and cultural scene; and,

WHEREAS, the 2024 Off Beat Festival will be held from October 5th to October 7th, providing an opportunity for residents and visitors to experience a diverse array of artistic expressions and cultural experiences; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Jenny Brekhus in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to Future Kind; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
