Summary:

This is an application (R148109Q-AMD-2024a) to add on-premises alcohol to an existing liquor manufacturer licensee and to expand from suites 28 and 57 into 25, 26, 27, 29, 56, 58, 59, 60, and 127. The licensee also holds alcohol manufacturer's package alcohol and alcohol catering licenses. The site location was approved by the Planning Division.

Zoning/Planning Review: Industrial Commercial (IC). Manufacturing, Distribution, and Distillery are allowed uses. On-premises alcohol service is allowed from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
