**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RENO APPOINTING THE CITY
MANAGER OR HIS ASSIGNED DESIGNEE AS THE AUTHORIZED
REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO NEVADA
REVISED STATUTES 338.1693 TO APPOINT THE INTERVIEW
PANEL(S) AND TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE MOST
QUALIFIED APPLICANT FOR PRECONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR
CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK FOR THE RENO FIRE
DEPARTMENT CENTRAL STATION PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes 338.1693 provides that the public body or its authorized representative must appoint or authorize a representative to appoint a panel(s) that will rank proposals and conduct interviews of the applicants; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes 338.1693 further provides that the public body or its authorized representative is to enter into negotiations with the most qualified applicant for preconstruction services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Reno to have such direction and authority set forth by resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, based upon the foregoing recitals and findings which are incorporated by reference, that the City Manager or his assigned designee, pursuant to NRS 338.1693, is appointed as the authorized representative of the City of Reno City Council to appoint the interview panel(s) and to enter into negotiations with the most qualified applicant for preconstruction services for the Reno Fire Department Central Station project.
