APPLICATION FOR A RESTRICTED GAMING LICENSE

APPROVED, CONDITIONED:

- (1) A RESTRICTED GAMING LICENSE SHALL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL A PONY WALL WHICH SEPARATES THE SLOT MACHINES FROM THE REST OF THE LOCATION IS ADDED AND APPROVED BY THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD ENFORCEMENT DIVISION.**
- (2) PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF THE STATE GAMING LICENSE, A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE SLOT ROUTE OPERATOR AND THE ASIAN MARKET MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD CHAIR OR THE CHAIR'S DESIGNEE.**
- (3) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSEE OR BUSINESS OPERATOR WHO IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE SHALL BE ASSIGNED TO SUPERVISE AND ACTIVELY MONITOR THE MACHINES AT ALL TIMES THE MACHINES ARE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC FOR PLAY.**
- (4) THE SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM AND/OR MIRROR(S) MUST BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD ENFORCEMENT DIVISION WITHIN 60 DAYS OF ISSUANCE OF THE STATE GAMING LICENSE AND THEREAFTER BE MAINTAINED AT OR ABOVE THE STANDARD THAT IS APPROVED.**
