

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
THE RENO BIKE PROJECT TO SUPPORT ITS MISSION OF
ADVOCATING FOR A SUSTAINABLE CYCLING COMMUNITY
THROUGH EDUCATION, COLLABORATION, AND ACCESSIBILITY IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Reno is committed to promoting sustainability, accessibility, and healthy living within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Reno Bike Project is a 501(c)(3) non-profit community bicycle shop that advocates for a sustainable cycling community through education, collaboration, and the provision of accessible resources for the public in the Truckee Meadows; and

WHEREAS, the Reno Bike Project works to make cycling accessible by recycling and recirculating used bicycles into the community at affordable prices, encouraging self-sufficiency through bicycle mechanics workshops, and providing a space for community members to repair their own bicycles; and

WHEREAS, the Reno Bike Project promotes cycling activism and advocates for cycling rights and growth by collaborating with public officials and organizations involved in transportation planning, contributing to a more bike-friendly infrastructure in the Truckee Meadows; and

WHEREAS, the Reno Bike Project organizes cycling-related events for a variety of audiences, promoting community engagement, youth safety, and contributing to the diverse and vibrant cultural landscape of Reno; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Brekhus in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to the Reno Bike Project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
