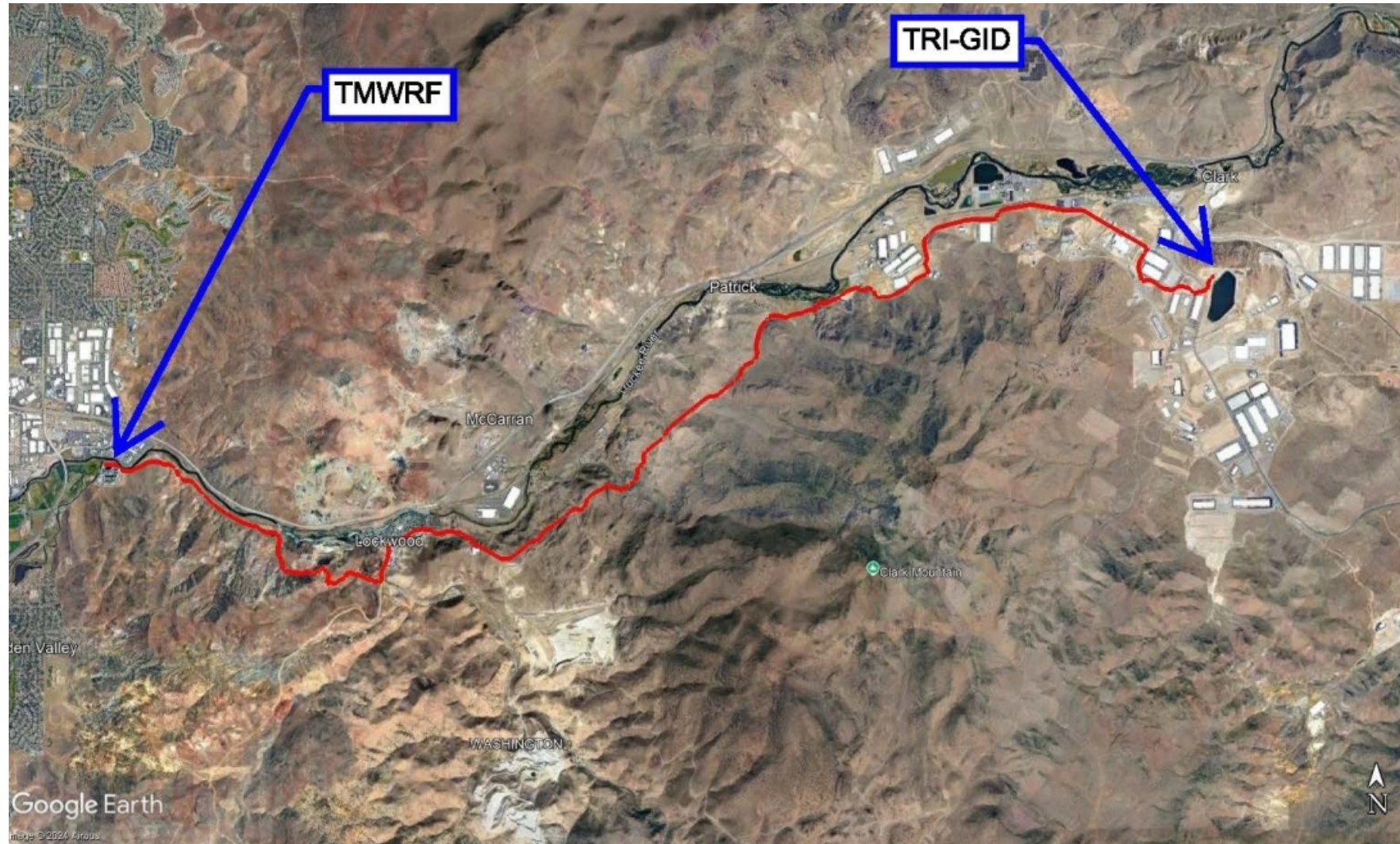
What is the TRI-GID Pump Station and Pipeline?

- Effluent Agreement Approved
 - September 2017
 - Stipulated rate study and rate establishment
- TRI-GID constructed/funded infrastructure
- Benefits TMWRF (COR/COS)
- Portion of infrastructure operated and maintained by TMWRF



Pipeline

- 16 miles
- Maintained by TRI-GID



TRI-GID Rate Setting

What This Item Is...

- Rate establishment between COR/COS and TRI-GID
- Rate per 1,000 gallons
- Rate based on cost to maintain/operate infrastructure

What This Item Is Not...

- Construction project
 - Infrastructure already in-place
- Cost to the City
- Commitment to future funding
- Revenue source
