RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STREETS

Avid Drive, Plump Jack Lane, Editor Drive, and a portion of Drever Way

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to provide public streets; and

WHEREAS, Avid Drive, Plump Jack Lane, Editor Drive, and a portion of Drever Way, was offered for dedication by the Official Plat of Military 8, recorded in the office of the Washoe County Recorder as document number 5338433, being a Subdivision of Deed Doc No. 5283498, lying within the NW ¼ of Section 4, T.20N., R.19E, M.D.M., City of Reno, Washoe County, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, said offer of dedication was previously rejected by the City because the streets were not improved to City standards; and

WHEREAS, NRS 278.390 specifically provides if at the time a final map is approved and the streets are rejected, the offer of dedication shall be deemed to remain open and the governing body may by resolution at any later date without further action by the subdivider, rescind its action and accept and open the streets for public use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the streets have been improved to City standards, and it is now in the best interest of the public to accept said streets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Reno City Council, pursuant to the authority granted by NRS 278.390 to hereby accept the dedication of the streets hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, and hereby ordered that this Resolution be recorded in the office of the Washoe County Recorder.
