Previous Council Action:

Council has approved grant awards for Enforcement of Underage Drinking Laws (EUDL) through JTNN in prior years; the most recent includes the fiscal year (FY) 23/24 EUDL grant award accepted during the June 14, 2023, Council Meeting – Item B.15.

Background:**Discussion:**

JTNN continues to be a dedicated partner with the City of Reno to combat underage drinking. The purpose of the RPD funding is to assist in operations to determine whether establishments are complying with laws prohibiting the sale of alcohol to individuals under the age of 21. This includes personnel funding for under-age drinking patrols at establishments selling or serving alcohol, including during special events such as “pub crawls” and “wine walks.”

Financial Implications:

RPD has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$8,747.45. The term of this grant is from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025. There are no match requirements.

Legal Implications:

The City, by accepting these grants, agrees to comply with the terms of the grant applications, provide data upon request for evaluation to the granting organization, and provide reports as needed, which will be completed by the appropriate police department personnel. Failure to adhere to the grant requirements could affect future grant funding.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends Council accept the Join Together Northern Nevada (JTNN) grant to the City of Reno Police Department (RPD) in the amount of \$8,747.45 and authorize the Chief of Police to sign the necessary documents.
