AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL TITLE 8, CHAPTER 8.12 SECTION 8.12.012 OF THE RENO MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED “PROHIBITION AGAINST SITTING OR LYING IN DOORWAYS; PENALTY”; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENO DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Title 8, Chapter 8.12, § 8.12.012 of the Reno Municipal Code is hereby repealed as follows:

~~Sec. 8.12.012. Prohibition against sitting or lying in doorways; penalty.~~

- ~~(a) No person shall sit or lie down in any entrance to any building if that entrance is posted with a sign prohibiting such conduct. For purposes of this section, "entrance" means the entire area between the outer edge of an entrance to a building and the exterior door, and includes the entry way, doorway or vestibule.~~
- ~~(b) The prohibition contained in this section shall not apply to any person sitting or lying down in any entrance to a building due to a medical emergency.~~
- ~~(c) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.~~

SECTION 2. The Reno City Council hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to the requirements of Chapter 237 of NRS, Business Impact Statement process.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication in one issue of a newspaper printed and published in the City of Reno.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk and Clerk of the City Council of the City of Reno is hereby authorized and directed to have this Ordinance published in one issue of the Reno-Gazette Journal, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Reno.
