**RESOLUTION DONATING CERTAIN
EQUIPMENT IDENTIFIED AS ONE (1) 2000
FORD F350 AMBULANCE TO THE NEVADA
PEER SUPPORT INCIDENT SUPPORT
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 268.028, the City of Reno may donate commodities, supplies, materials and equipment that the governing body determines have reached the end of their useful lives to another governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program is a 501(c)(3) Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reno owns one (1) 2000 Ford F350 ambulance, VIN Number 1FDWF36F5YED43354; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reno no longer utilizes the ambulance in front-line service because of its age and excessive maintenance costs; its running gear is obsolete, expensive and difficult to repair and, since the ambulance is 25 years old, it has exceeded its scheduled life expectancy; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization desires to own and utilize the ambulance in its mission to provide peer support services and enhance their ability to provide mobile assistance and outreach to first responders; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the public, and it substantially benefits the citizens of the City of Reno and the Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program, for Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program to own and utilize the ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reno desires to decommission the ambulance and donate it to the Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program in “as is” condition without warranties, whether express or implied, of any kind; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the decommissioning of the ambulance and donation of the ambulance, as defined above, in “as is” condition to the Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program, without warranties, whether express or implied, of any kind. Nevada Peer Support Incident Support Program shall make arrangements for transfer of the Fire Engines and shall be responsible for all costs associated therewith, including transportation, and if applicable, registration, insurance, and other associated costs.
