

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO  
NOAH’S ANIMAL HOUSE IN SUPPORT OF THEIR MISSION TO  
REMOVE THE "NO PETS ALLOWED" BARRIER AT WOMEN’S  
SHELTERS FOR THE COURAGEOUS SURVIVORS LOOKING TO GET  
BACK ON THEIR FEET WITH THEIR PET BY THEIR SIDE IN THE  
AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, Noah's Animal House is a full-service pet facility located on the grounds of a domestic violence shelter; and,

**WHEREAS**, Noah's Animal House seeks to eliminate the "No Pets Allowed" barrier at women’s shelters, providing a vital service for courageous survivors of domestic violence who are seeking to rebuild their lives with their pets by their side; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the importance of supporting organizations that contribute to the well-being and safety of survivors of domestic violence and their companion animals; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Vice Mayor Duerr in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Noah’s Animal House; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
