Hello,

I am writing regarding the proposed Chapter 9 entitled "Adult Oriented Businesses."

We operate two adult-oriented retail businesses in Reno ("Suzies"), with our original location successfully operating there, incident-free for over 25 years. I have extensive experience operating adult businesses nationally and have an in-depth understanding of adult business-related ordinances and their legalities and histories.

In short, the practical reality of the proposed Chapter 9 is that it would likely force the closure of these businesses - costing Reno 40+ high-paying jobs, thousands in sales taxes, and lawful access for the 10,000 monthly consenting adults who currently visit Suzies to purchase constitutionally-protected adult entertainment merchandise.

To my knowledge, there has never been any incident of "criminality" or "adverse secondary effects" nearby these two retail establishments, nor has there been any adverse effect on the "stability of property values." To the contrary, from 1994 to 2022, the former Suzies property on Kietzke Avenue actually appreciated nearly 2,000% in value.

It is hard to understand why the purchase of merchandise such as adult novelties for off-premises consumption could possibly have "adverse secondary effects," but Chapter 9 seeks to make the purchase of such merchandise illegal at a retail store. The government has no place in regulating what goes on in the privacy of one's home, and by making it harder to purchase merchandise one might use in his home, that's exactly what the government is doing.

It is equally hard to understand why the City of Reno has a vested interest in requiring an employee selling an adult novelty (such as a sex toy) to obtain an expensive work card from the government. Cashiers at convenience stores regularly sell products much more harmful than a vibrator (such as alcohol or tobacco products that can, in fact, be deadly), but the City of Reno trusts them to sell those more dangerous products free of such oversight?

Perhaps most difficult to understand is why a retail establishment selling adult novelties needs a full-time licensed uniformed security guard. This requirement alone will render most adult stores unprofitable as these guards cost \$50+ per hour. While many gas stations in Reno regularly suffer assaults, robberies, and drug use on their properties, the City of Reno has not required such establishments to hire full-time licensed uniformed security guards.

The common theme of these silly requirements (among many others in the proposed Chapter 9) is that they are solely designed to put adult retail stores out of business by making it prohibitively expensive and difficult to legally operate. The irony, of course, is that these same toys are now available at Wal-Mart, Target, and even Walgreens.

At its root, these ordinances are often drafted by religious zealots whose misogyny and homophobia permeate through the endless list of onerous regulations. The template from which Chapter 9 was drafted was likely started with a draft written by such an individual. I am confident that you are intelligent enough to see through that curtain of deceit and recognize what the proposed Chapter 9 really is - an affront to the First Amendment and a backhanded attempt to shutter these businesses.

The US Supreme Court has held that adult products are protected by the First Amendment, which was not written to protect speech that everybody likes; it was written to protect speech that sometimes is disliked. I do not hide the fact that adult entertainment is sometimes disliked (even when privately consumed solely by consenting adults), but in your obligation to the constitution, it is your duty to protect such speech equally and without discrimination. Censorship and government interference in the private lives of consenting adults is commonplace in Iran and North Korea, not the United States. One cannot fairly say they value freedom, yet want to meddle in the private lives of grown adults, just as one cannot fairly say they are pro-business and anti-bureaucracy, yet want to strangle these small businesses with red tape.

These businesses have operated quietly and safely for many decades in Reno with no issues. Please omit Chapter 9 from your code updates, if not for the sake of the First Amendment, for the sake of the consenting adults who simply aren't bothering anybody else.

Should the opportunity present itself, I would enjoy the opportunity to respectfully plead for the jobs of the 40+ employees who work at these businesses who will be forced into unemployment should Chapter 9 become a reality.

Reno City Council approved a partnership agreement in May with Nevada Energy (NVE) to collaborate on a shared vision to reduce emissions, increase local renewable energy, and support energy-related solutions that are accessible and equitable. NVE has requested that the Public Utilities Commission of NV (PUCN) approve a monthly increase in the base service charge (BSC) from \$16.50 to \$45.30-- the highest in the US. The BSC is the amount an individual pays NVE before flipping a single light switch—the amount paid just to be an NVE customer. The average NVE customer's bill will increase nearly 9%. If person uses nothing electric in his/her home, or if the home is powered by solar, his/her NVE bill will nearly triple. Low- and fixed-income families, who typically use little electricity, will be financially burdened, while higher income, high energy-users will be rewarded by a concurrent decrease in electricity rates. Those who have installed solar will be penalized, and future solar installation will be disincentivized. Meanwhile, profits to NVE investors will increase to over 10%. NVE's proposed BSC increase conflicts with the vision of the Partnership agreement. Reno: call NVE on the carpet and protect our many low/fixed-income families. You and NVE agreed to increase renewable energy. You currently have several solar installations and more coming. The NV Clean Energy fund was recently awarded \$156 million to encourage solar installation by low-income families. The BSC increase discourages solar. The City should formally oppose the BSC increase, and inform NVE that Reno will not stand for NVE's double-talk regarding guidelines of the Partnership. Bill Miller Public Comment:

Reno's partnership agreement with NV Energy

Good morning Mayor Schieve, council members, staff and fellow citizens. I'm Bill Miller, resident and advocate for a livable climate in our fair city. I'm here to talk about Reno's partnership agreement with NV Energy, signed in May, and already violated by them in spirit and principle—by a backdoor request to triple their base rate, sabotaging rooftop solar for consumers and installations owned by the city of Reno.

I'm reminded of a fable about the scorpion and the frog. A scorpion asks a frog for a ride across a stream. The frog, being suspicious, says, "You are poisonous. How do I know you won't bite and kill me?" The scorpion replies, "Because, if I did, we would both sink and drown." The frog thinks it over and decides to give the scorpion a ride. Halfway across, the scorpion sinks his fangs into the frog. As they are sinking the frog cries, "Why did you do that?" and the scorpion answers, "because that is my nature."

So, let's examine the natures of the NV Energy and the Reno Council. The council is empowered by citizens to protect the public welfare, build and repair infrastructure, plan for sensible growth and protect our environment, in which it is doing a remarkable job.

NV Energy is a publicly traded corporation, owned by an out of state investor, beholden to Wall Street and managed, by law, solely for the financial benefit of its shareholders. NV Energy not only has no stake in the health and wellbeing of our citizens; it is, in fact, tasked with making as much money as possible, in any way it can.

So how does NV Energy ensure the largest possible returns? Essentially by building or converting power plants that burn dirty fossil fuels and emit dangerous heat trapping gases. Worse, it simultaneously resists highly beneficial infrastructure improvements like rooftop solar that it can't monetize.
