Execute an interlocal agreement with NDOT for Reno to bid the construction contract & NDOT to reimburse the City for work conducted in their ROW

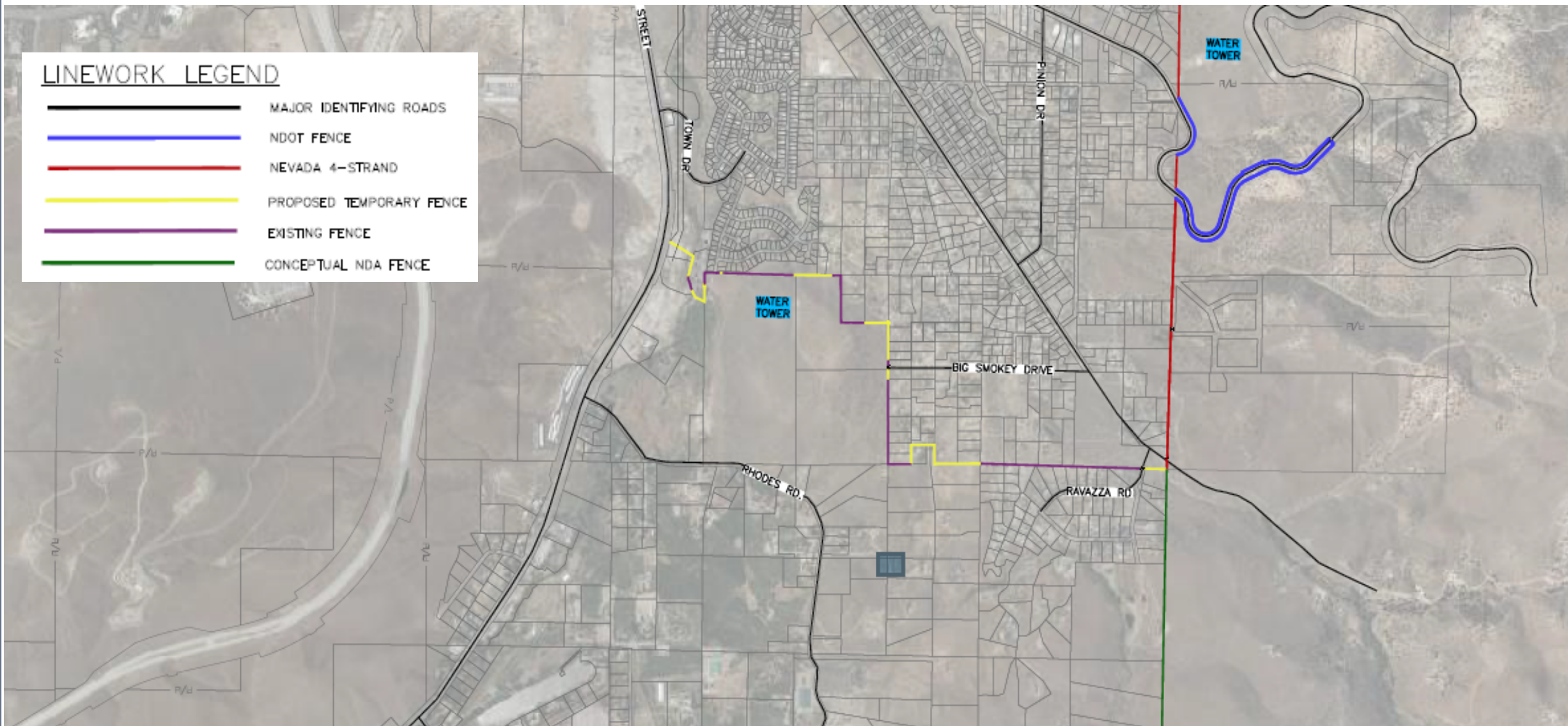
Staff is preparing bid documents & requests Interim City Manager be granted signing authority to award the contract



# Phase 1 Fencing

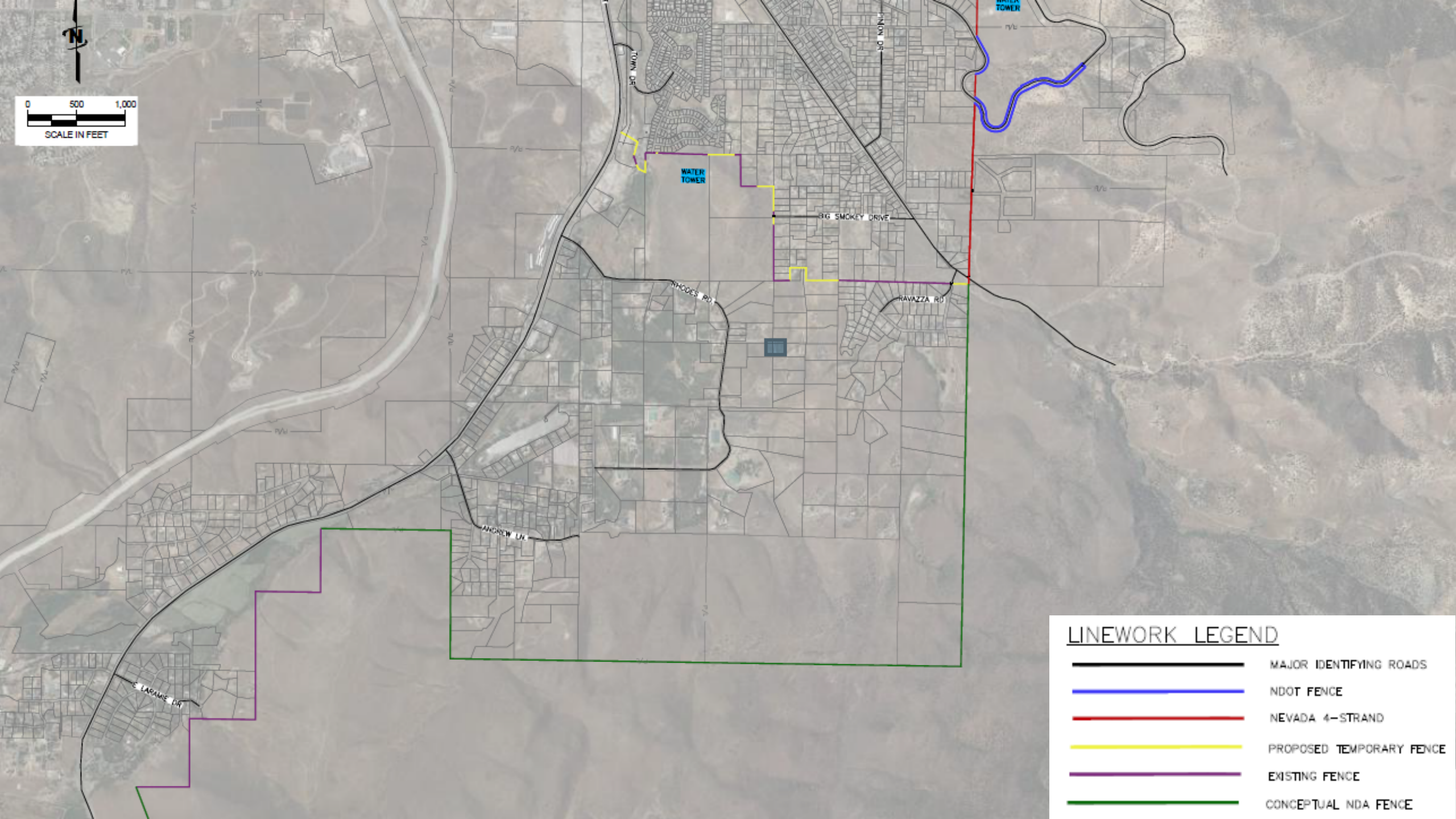
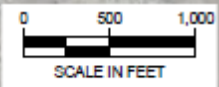






## Phase 2 Alignment

## Item D.7 Recommended Motion

I move to approve the Interlocal Agreement for reimbursement by the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) to the City to install and construct wildlife fencing along State Route 341 (Geiger Grade) as part of the City's Horse Protection Project – South Phase in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.



## Item D.8 Recommended Motion

I move to authorize the award of a contract for the installation of wildlife fencing and other appurtenances for the Horse Protection Project – South Phase in accordance with competitive bidding laws set forth in Chapter 338 of NRS in an amount not to exceed \$660,000 and provide authorization for the Interim City Manager to sign the contract.
