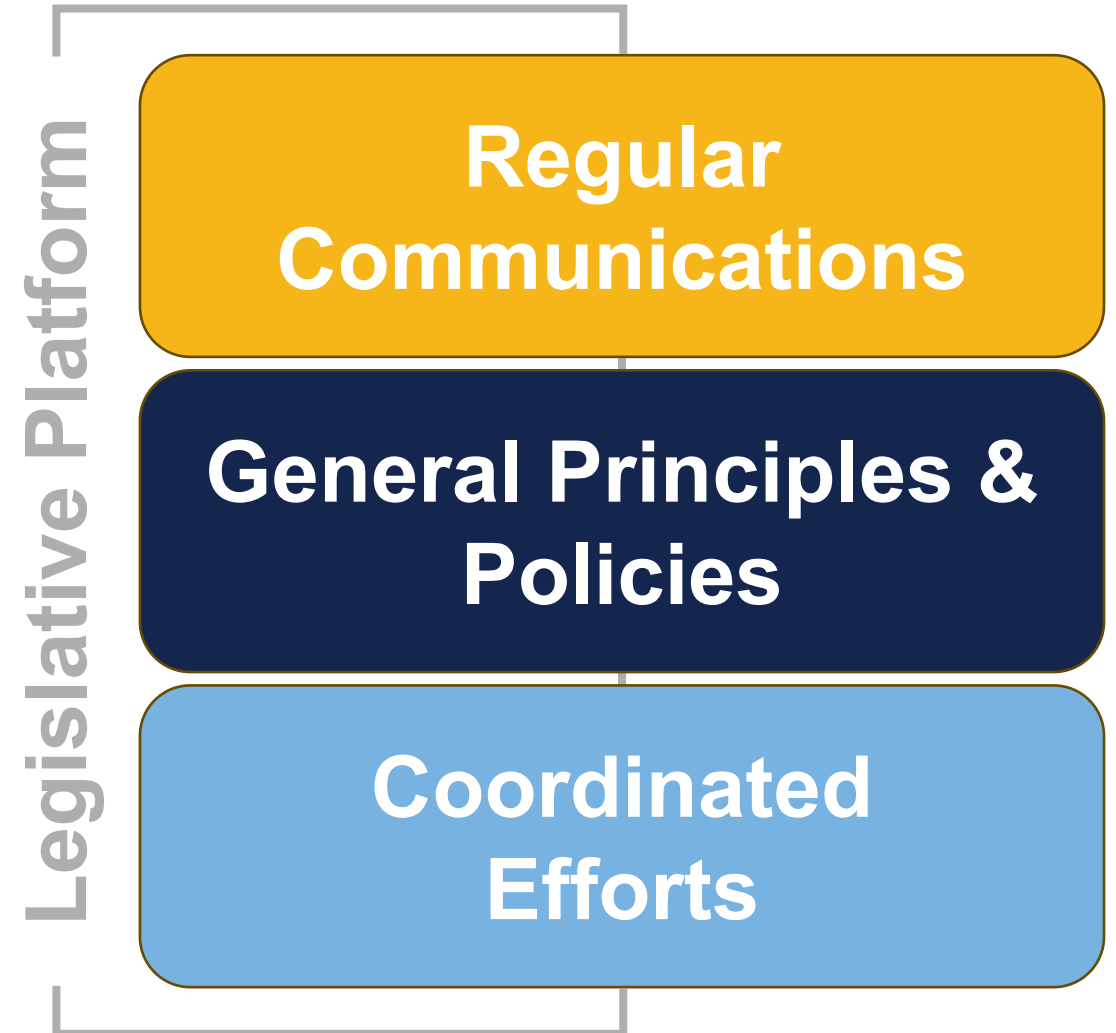

- Extensive Impacts
 - 1,096 bills introduced (82nd Session)
 - Followed ~31% (343)

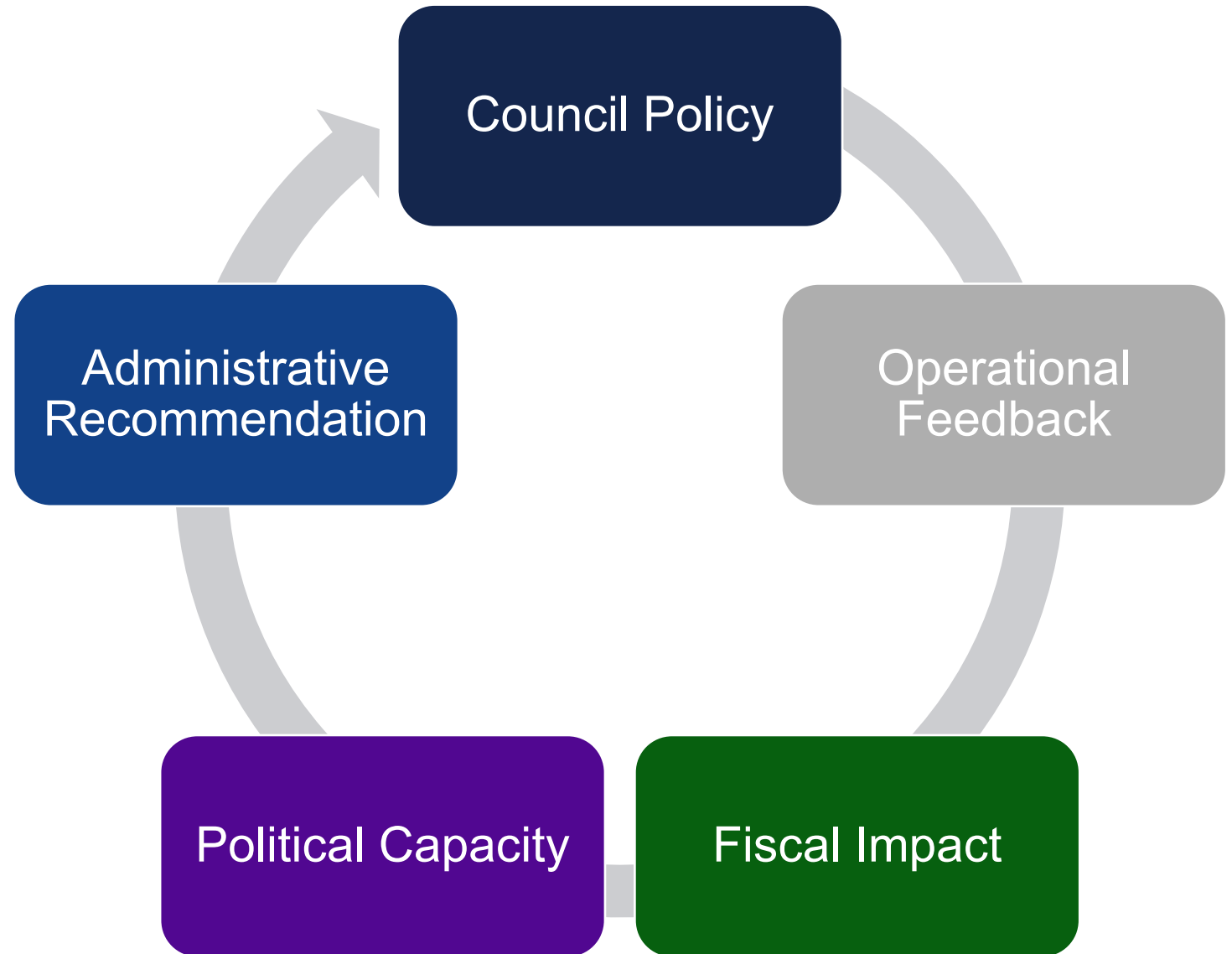
