
Previous Council Action:

There is no recent Council action relevant to this item.

Discussion:

UNR is in the process of constructing the Mathewson Gateway College of Business building along the west side of University Way on the UNR campus. UNR has requested to place four (4) four-inch conduits along with two (2) six-inch chilled water lines across University Way to provide fiber optic interconnection and chilled water between the new building and the rest of campus. Additionally, four (4) four-inch conduits for fiber optic interconnection will be placed across E 9th Street. The approximate easement locations are shown on the vicinity map. The proposed infrastructure will be owned and maintained by UNR with the City holding rights to the public right of way.
