RESOLUTION TO JOIN NATIONAL FITNESS CAMPAIGN (NFC) HEALTHY CITIES CAMPAIGN, QUALIFY FOR GRANT FUNDING, AND RECEIVE A HEALTHY INFRASTRUCTURE MASTER PLAN

At a meeting of the Reno City Council held on March 27, 2024 wherein the following action was taken:

WHEREAS, the City of Reno recognizes the growing health crisis in America of preventable diseases born of inactivity and sedentary lifestyles, and recognizes the important impact the built environment, parks, pedestrian infrastructure and outdoor Fitness Courts® have on building healthier communities, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno has a population that exceeds 100,000 people, and qualifies for the NFC “Model City” Grants and Services provided for the 500 largest municipalities in America, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno has submitted a Application to National Fitness Campaign (NFC), to qualify for participation in the NFC nationwide Healthy Cities Campaign, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno will accept the conditional award of \$170,000 in National Grant funding from the NFC Grant Committee and Statewide Partners, and cooperate with NFC to develop a long term plan for the deployment of Fitness Courts® and Healthy Infrastructure across their municipality in coordination with the current Parks Master Plan, Capital Plans, and Community Feedback where appropriate, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno will cooperate with NFC to develop a local funding plan, and secure supplemental funding as needed through state, federal, and local resources, and implement a phasing plan for the deployment of a network Fitness Courts® over time to serve its residents, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno will identify a staff liaison to collaborate with the National Fitness Campaign Wellness Architecture group to support the development of this program, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Reno] believes the outdoor Fitness Court® program and Healthy Cities Campaign provides an important wellness ecosystem that supports healthier communities, commits to cooperating with NFC to plan, fund and build Healthy Infrastructure, and will earn local and national recognition as a leader in providing affordable health and wellness opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno will collaborate with NFC with intent to join the National Fitness Campaign, and make world class fitness free for community residents and visitors.
