The Carson City Public Works Department, Streets Division has offered to donate 88 traffic conflict monitors to the City of Reno Maintenance and Operations Department for use by the Street Maintenance Division. The conflict monitors have an approximate value of \$1,350 each, with the approximate value of the donation being \$118,800.

The Traffic Signal Maintenance Section of the Street Maintenance Division currently utilizes the EDI MMU2-LEip conflict monitors in many of the City's signalized intersections. The Carson City Public Works Department is switching to a different manufacturer of conflict monitors and is therefore offering to donate its existing inventory to the City of Reno.

Financial Implications:
