RESOLUTION GRANTING 18 ARTS AND CULTURE PROJECT GRANTS FOR 2024: \$6,251 TO NEVADA HUMANITIES; \$6,185 TO NOTE-ABLE MUSIC THERAPY SERVICES; \$5,919 TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS, NEVADA SYSTEM OF HIGHER EDUCATION ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO LILLEY MUSEUM OF ART; \$5,852 TO PIONEER CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS; \$5,852 TO LATINO ARTE AND CULTURE; \$5,786 TO THE HOLLAND PROJECT; \$5,653 TO ARTS FOR ALL NEVADA; \$5,520 TO RENO LITTLE THEATER; \$5,453 TO NEVADA GAY MEN'S CHORUS; \$5,387 TO THE RENO BIKE PROJECT ON BEHALF OF KWNK RENO COMMUNITY RADIO; \$5,320 TO RENO JAZZ ORCHESTRA; \$5,254 TO SIERRA NEVADA BALLET; \$5,254 TO RENO CHAMBER ORCHESTRA; \$5,187 TO BLACK WALL STREET RENO; \$5,054 TO A.V.A. WHEREAS, the City of Reno may grant funds, subject to conditions, to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes pursuant to NRS 268.028 when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2023, the Reno Arts and Culture Commission reviewed the recommendations of the Grants Committee, which met on November 2, 2023, to review the grant applications identified in Exhibit A, and recommended approval of grants to the following nonprofit arts and culture organizations:
