

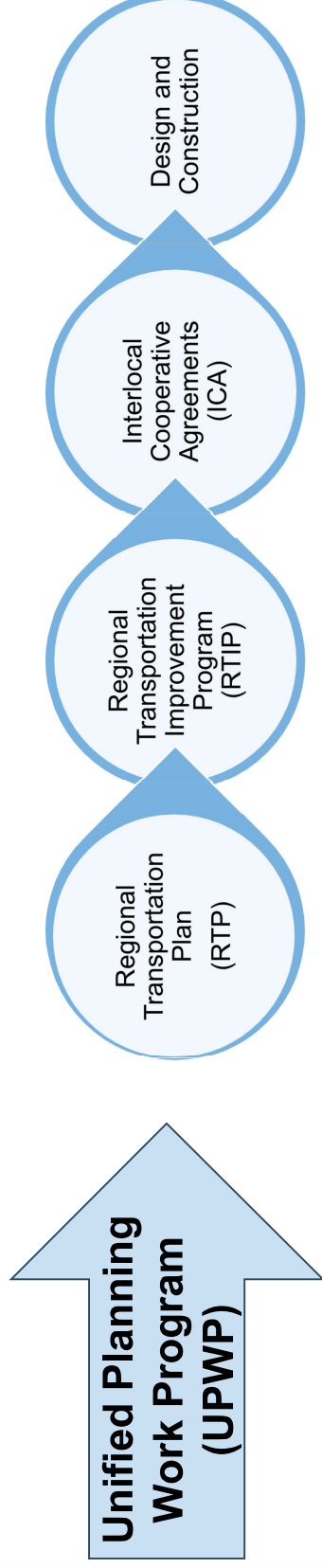

- ✓ Funds concept-level transportation planning or studies

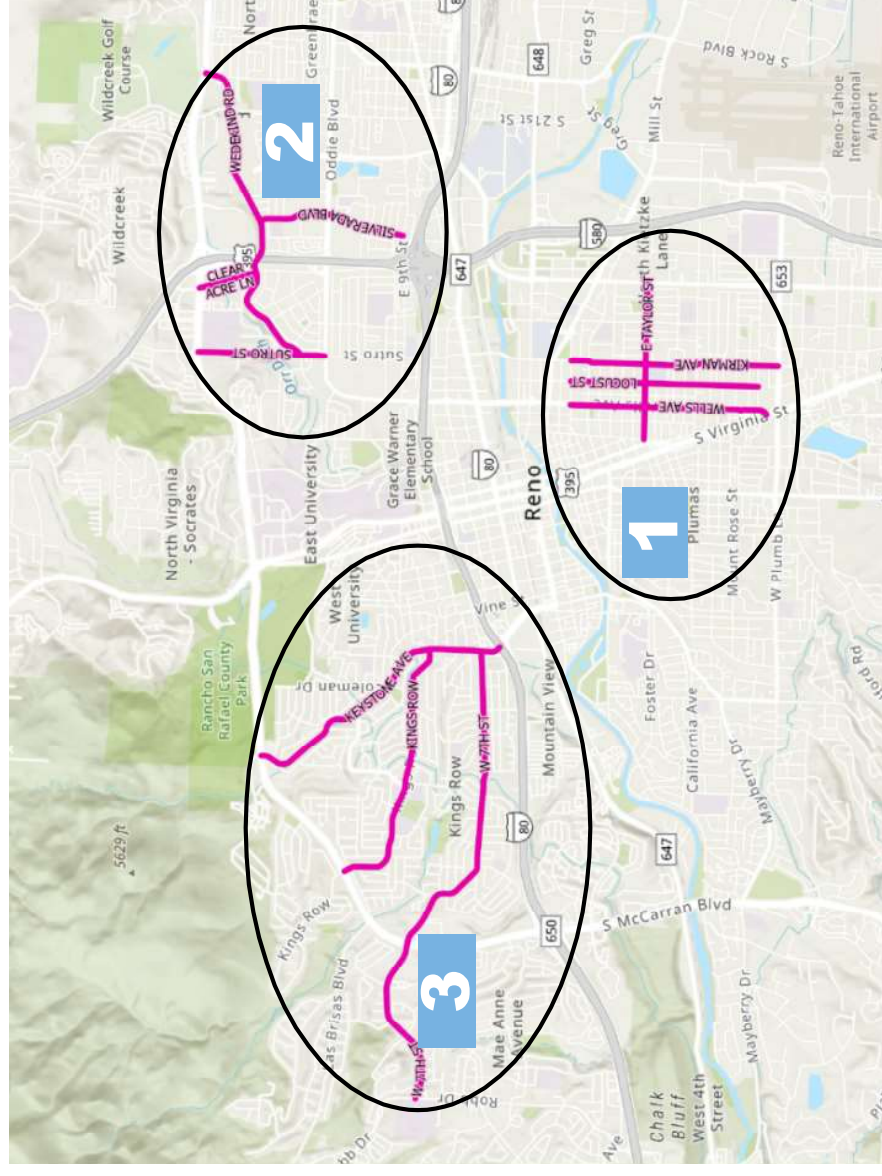


UPWP – Proposals

- Advance federal and regional goals and priorities.
- Ranked by the local agency.

Regional Truck Route Plan

- Address freight movement on Regional roads
- Create objective criteria to designate select specific Regional roads as “Through Truck Routes”
- Improve multi-modal safety
- Improve quality of life
- Maintain infrastructure in state of good repair

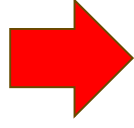
