

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
CORAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCE TO SUPPORT THEIR MISSION TO
PROVIDE A SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT, SUPPORTED BY A
DIVERSE COMMUNITY, AND A STUDENT BODY THAT IS
DEDICATED TO RIGOROUS COLLEGE PREPARATORY
CURRICULUM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500. (GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Coral Academy of Science, focuses on uniquely preparing students to succeed i college and secure high-earning, competitive, and rewarding careers after college; and,

WHEREAS, Coral Academy of Science views its primary mission as designing and implementing a unique and challenging educational environments for students which will promote positive academic and social success during and beyond their high school years; and,

WHEREAS, Coral Academy of Science is a tuition-free K-12 public charter school sponsored by Washoe County School District and serves over 1,500 students in the Reno area; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Ebert in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to Coral Academy of Science; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
