

RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO NOAH’S ANIMAL HOUSE FOUNDATION, TO SUPPORT THEIR MISSION TO REMOVE THE “NO PETS ALLOWED” BARRIER AT WOMEN’S SHELTERS FOR THE COURAGEOUS SURVIVORS LOOKING TO GET BACK ON THEIR FEET WITH THEIR PET BY THEIR SIDE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500. (GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028, entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, Noah’s Animal House Foundation, a 501(c) 3 organization, that provides on-site pet shelter and care for victims of domestic violence; and,

WHEREAS, Noah’s Animal House Foundation, works in conjunction with the Domestic Violence Resource Center, to ensure that victims no longer have to leave their companions behind; and,

WHEREAS, Noah’s Animal House Foundation, has two locations in Nevada, has served clients over 34 states, where victims travel thousand of miles to be able to receive care for themselves and their companions; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Taylor in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to the Noah’s Animal House Foundation to support their mission to remove the “no pets allowed” barrier at women’s shelters for the courageous survivors looking to get back on their feet with their pet by their side; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
