(6) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(5), above, only that portion of sign copy regulated by NRS Sections 590.160 - 590.330, *Advertisement of Motor Vehicle Fuel and Petroleum Products*, ✓ may be animated provided that:

- a. The display brightness does not exceed [redacted] nise; ✓
- b. Displays do not appear to be in motion
- c. Displays change no more than 24 times per hour
- d. All other sign regulations in this Title [redacted] regulations (including zoning limitations, [redacted] remain in effect.

3.05.115 Nonconforming On-Premises

"nonconforming on-premise sign" is a sign that does not comply with sign regulations codified in this chapter, or subsequent regulations, but was permitted under the current provisions of such regulations. Such a sign may be maintained without a conditional use permit and is subject to the provisions of this chapter or of Section 18.05.116.
