Objective: Summarize my experience and expertise related to planning, design and construction of historic properties for consideration to the Historic Resources Commission, City of Reno, NV. For approximately thirty years I managed projects/programs that utilized the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Treatments of Historic Properties. Project planning included alternative consideration for reconstruction, rehabilitation, stabilization and/or demolition to comply with not only the proposed use, but current building codes, including accessibility, energy efficiency, water efficiency, as well as other federal mandates (sustainability, climate change). I've worked with multi-disciplinary teams to determine appropriate architectural design solutions (finishes, furnishings, hardware, roofing, widows, etc.), as well as for archeological issues (siting, configuration). I have successfully consulted on projects with the California, Oregon and Pennsylvania State Historic Preservation Offices for required approvals, including negotiations for appropriate mitigations. I have served as the lead in submitting projects for the National Park Service (NPS) Board approval. I was a standing advisor to the NPS Development Advisory Board as well as serving on local architectural committees (Colorado and Nevada), which in all situations required me to review/approve historic projects, and contemporary development.
