This is unacceptable and very dangerous to the safety and well-being of the mustangs in this area. Who do they think they are to do such a thing? WE ARE THE TAXPAYERS AND WE VOTERS AND ARE SICK AND TIRED OF SEEING OUR BEAUTIFUL WILD LIFE BE HUNTED, KILLED RAN OUT OF THEIR HOME AND DYING FOR RANCHERS, DEVELOPERS BUILDERS AND POLITICIANS.

There are humane compromises available that would preserve existing access for all wildlife and enable the landowner to proceed with development when they have the required approvals in place and the new access point to water is opened.

In the meantime, the fencing must be open immediately until a compromise solution is reached.

This situation exemplifies the need for the City Council to fund the South Reno fencing project fully. This would protect both community drivers and the historic and beloved Virginia Range horses. WATER IS LIFE & LIFE IS WATER!

It has come to our attention that the horses at the Meadow just past Rio Wrangler are fenced out of their water supply. Sunny Hills, the developer of the land, put up a new fence that keeps the horses away from their natural resource for water. Our understanding is that at this time, the developer does not have a permit to build yet, but has chosen to put up a fence that keeps the horses from their water source.

An alternate water source is not available at this time and the horses have no access to water. They are in distress running the fence line and some are even jumping the fence. In this picture, a young foal is too little to jump the fence and so he tries to go through it and gets caught up. Mom is obviously frantic. The foal did make it out after a struggle.

The developer's actions prove that he does NOT care about our horses. WE DO!

This situation needs to be addressed immediately. Lives are literally at stake.
