Discussions with Code Enforcement and licensees revealed that vinyl signage on store frontage windows often acts as an advertisement and a sunshade. The signage can be seen through at close proximity during the day and from further away at night. Code Enforcement will be working with PD to ensure that safety and welfare standards are being met and will work with the licensee to make any changes as deemed necessary.
