

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
THE HOLLAND PROJECT IN SUPPORT OF THEIR MISSION OF
PROVIDING ART, MUSIC, AND CULTURE OPPORTUNITIES FOR
YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE TRUCKEE MEADOWS IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Reno recognizes the value of promoting cultural engagement and creative opportunities for young people as a vital part of fostering a vibrant and thriving community; and,

WHEREAS, The Holland Project is a non-profit, all-ages arts and music initiative by young people, for young people, providing access to art, music, workshops, and skill-building opportunities in the Truckee Meadows; and,

WHEREAS, The Holland Project produces more than 250 all-ages events annually, including live music, gallery exhibits, workshops, and special events that support Reno’s cultural development and provide diverse opportunities for youth to engage in creative expression; and,

WHEREAS, The Holland Project's efforts to foster a strong urban scene for art and music align with the City of Reno’s commitment to supporting arts and cultural initiatives that enhance the quality of life for its residents and contribute to a dynamic community; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Brekhus in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to the Holland Project; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
