NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- Section 1: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$7,710,971 in the General Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$301,142,025 to \$308,852,996 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 2: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$16,753,590 in the Street Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$54,932,364 to \$71,685,954 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 3: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$221,131 in the Room Tax Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$4,410,393 to \$4,631,524 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 4: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$1,349,470 in the Court Special Revenue Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$292,229 to \$1,641,699 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 5: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget

by appropriating \$788,426 in the Forfeiture Special Revenue Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$100,000 to \$888,426 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.

- Section 6: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$31,937,029 in the General Capital Project Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$97,040,905 to \$128,977,934 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.

 Section 7: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$4,350 in the Room Surcharge Capital Project Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$3,000,000 to \$3,004,350 a detailed schedule is
- Section 8: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$24,000 in the Bond Capital Project Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$0 to \$24,000 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.

- Section 9: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$997,491 in the Park District Capital Project Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$13,570,589 to \$14,568,080 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 10: The City Council of the City of Reno, Nevada shall augment its 2022/2023 budget by appropriating \$1,239,166 in the Capital Tax Fund, thereby increasing its appropriations from \$700,000 to \$1,939,166 a detailed schedule is attached to this Resolution and by reference is made a part hereof.
- Section 11: That staff is hereby directed to file said augmentations with the Department of Taxation, State of Nevada.
