As a second-generation Renoite, father of young children, small business owner, Spanish-speaking public-interest attorney, and civically engaged member of our community for more than 30 years, I bring a cross-section of perspectives to the table. I would offer my lived experience, professional skillset, and years of serving our most vulnerable neighbors as reasons why I am well-equipped to step into this role during a time of transition and to represent Ward 3 in the most accessible, capable, and loving way possible.

Our family has had our house in the heart of Ward 3 since 2010, and these neighborhoods are home to our favorite places to eat, play, and recreate. Commuting by bicycle (to my Ward 3 office) gives me a ground-level knowledge of our city, a personal stake in ensuring safe streets for all users, and an intimate view of Reno's exciting changes and ongoing challenges. I know Reno and Ward 3 deeply, and I am committed to making them vibrant, livable spaces for diverse Renoites.

Early in my career, I ran a non-profit immigration program and learned how to achieve the best results possible for my clients while working within ethical boundaries and the confines of flawed statutes. As a solo attorney with a varied practice, I routinely must familiarize myself with new facts, unfamiliar laws, and a dizzying set of procedures. Resolving court cases often requires negotiating in good faith and building relationships that can survive disagreement. My training and experience—legal and law-adjacent—would ease my transition into this role on the Council.


My work has always centered justice and service to others. In my day jobs, I have served people who are immigrants, juveniles, neurodiverse, queer, survivors of violent crime, unhoused, and otherwise vulnerable. (As you know, these identities are often intersectional.) On my own time, I have helped make voting districts fairer, reduce sentencing disparities for noncitizens, and more. I have taught "Know Your Rights" classes, supported workers' collectives, and mediated evictions. Where I cannot walk in others' shoes, I march alongside them with support and in service.

When the Council makes big decisions, the process can seem at once too fast to influence and too slow to follow at every turn. This was my perception as a young man, but it taught me that an engaged and organized citizenry is essential to a meaningful democracy. This structure is elusive, because the work of building it is hard. If I were selected for this role, community outreach and involvement would be cornerstones of my tenure on the Council.

Thank you for the opportunity to be considered for this position. I look forward to meeting with you and with the community to discuss how I could serve Ward 3 as its next councilmember.
