

## Dear Licensee:

On behalf of the City of Reno ("City"), notice is hereby given that you are requested and required to appear before an Administrative Hearing Officer to show cause, if any, as to why the above referenced business license issued under Reno Municipal Code ("RMC") Title 4 and Title 5 should not be revoked or suspended.

This action is taken as the result of the information provided in the attached memorandum issued by the Reno Police Department ("RPD") and the Reno Code Enforcement Division ("Code") on October 18, 2022. As noted, RPD and Code detail various violations occurring on and connected to the business and business property.

Consequently, the City has scheduled a hearing before an Administrative Hearing Officer as to why your privileged business license to sell package alcohol should not be revoked or suspended for such period as may be determined.

The hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, October 25, 2022 at 9:00 a.m., via Zoom. You will receive an email regarding your Zoom link at prafulshivam@gmail.com. (Please be sure to check your junk or spam folders.) This hearing does not impact your ability to continue operations at this time.

If necessary, you may bring an interpreter to the hearing. If you fail to appear at the hearing, the Administrative Hearing Officer may still act on the City's request to revoke or suspend your license. The hearing will be electronically sound recorded.
