NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Mayor Hillary Schieve in the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to Camp Kesem National in support of the annual camp located at the University of Nevada, Reno; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
