

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO  
BABY’S BOUNTY TO SUPPORT THEIR MISSION TO SUPPORT AND  
EMPOWER AT-RISK FAMILIES BY PROVIDING EDUCATION AND  
THE ESSENTIAL TOOLS TO ENSURE A GOOD START FOR EVERY  
BABY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled “Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities” when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno has resolved to include Community Sustainability as an area of focus for 2023-2025; and,

**WHEREAS**, Baby’s Bounty’s mission is to support and empower at-risk families by providing education and the essential tools to ensure a good start for every baby; and,

**WHEREAS**, Baby’s Bounty has been in operation for 14 years, and has added recurring diaper banks to its programming; in Las Vegas, North Las Vegas, Henderson; and,

**WHEREAS**, Baby’s Bounty is launching soon in Northern Nevada; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Vice Mayor Devon Reese in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Baby’s Bounty; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
