

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO
THE SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF ERIN TO SUPPORT THEIR MISSION
TO REVIVE, FOSTER AND PROMOTE IRISH CULTURAL EVENTS,
INTERESTS, AND SENTIMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.
(GENERAL FUND)**

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Reno has resolved to include Arts, Parks, and Historical Resources as a strategic priority and goal; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Northern Nevada chapter of the Sons and Daughters of Erin is to promote charitable, educational, historic, and patriotic opportunities, and to collect and preserve Irish cultural traditions relating to any of the Irish peoples and to encourage the study of the Irish language, history, literature, and music; and,

WHEREAS, Over the clubs history it's made various contributions to the Northern Nevada community, including the establishment of St. Patrick's Grove in Rancho San Rafael Park; and annual parade participation in Reno, Virginia City and Carson City; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Vice Mayor Devon Reese in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to the Sons and Daughters of Erin in Northern Nevada; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
