Please know, that I have a long standing policy that I don't vote for agreements (including settlements) in which I have not seen the agreement as to be signed by Mayor or City Manager. Similarly, I believe that an attorney has a responsibility to make sure that clients are informed of binding decisions. Along these lines, the negotiated terms of an agreement should be available for viewing by a client (in this case the Council).

If negotiated terms are still being worked out and do not reach the level deemed of requiring Council approval (however I believe all litigation settlement matters are required to go before Council but DRT and I have a dispute regarding this), I request that I be provided written notice to any settlement and copied on any agreements.
