WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Reno has resolved to include Infrastructure, Climate Change, and Environmental Sustainability as strategic priorities and goals; and,

WHEREAS, Envirolution's vision is to create a world wherein the social, environmental, and economic spheres of our lives are prosperous and in balance, in which 100% of the energy used us sources from clean renewable sources; and,

WHEREAS, Envirolution has requested a grant in the amount of \$1,000 for 5 student scholarships for their 2023 Sustainability Expedition which aims to help teachers and students by raising awareness among youth to consider professions that save energy, water, and generate renewable energy; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Duerr in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Envirolution to be used for student scholarships for their 2023 sustainability expedition; and,
