


Paradise Park Project Area




Park Improvements

- Pathway improvements (2017) \$60,000
- Installation of mini-pitch courts (2021) \$225,000
- Activity Center roof and paint (2022) \$87,500
- Automatic parking lot entry gates (2022-2023) \$225,000
- Activity Center mural (Spring/Summer 2023) \$20,000
- Oddie/Wells Cycle Track Project (2023) RTC Project
- Comprehensive Park and Facility Master Plan (2023) \$98,500



Project Timeline




May 18, 2022 - Council Adopted the City Budget with CDBG Subcommittee Recommended Projects

B.7 Award of Contract to Spanish Springs for \$1,322,900

- Demolition of project site
- Preparation of restroom site
- Installation of playground structures and safety surfacing
- Installation of benches, picnic tables, and shade structures
- New sidewalks incorporated around the playground
- Upgraded landscaping
- Protective fence between the playground and parking lot



B.8. Approval of Additional Funding

- Previously Approved \$1,485,051
 - Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Project Cost \$2,081,739.38
- Difference \$596,688.38
 - Residential Construction Tax District 3 (RCT3) to fund the difference
