## RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DONATION FUNDS TO BLACK WALL STREET TO OFFSET THE COSTS ASSOCIATED TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT THAT WILL STRENGTHEN DISADVATAGED COMMUNITIES IN NORTHERN NEVADA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000. (GENERAL FUND)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028, entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

**WHEREAS,** Black Wall Street, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, is a community resource and youth center formed to meet the needs of black and other underserved minorities in the Reno/Sparks area; and,

**WHEREAS,** Black Wall Street, works to create and sustain a strong support system to promote literacy, education programs, and resources for all ages; and

WHEREAS, Black Wall Street, has collaborated with other outreach programs to host events to provide schools supplies, clothing, and other goods to community children in need; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Martinez in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to Black Wall Street to offset the costs associated with creating an environment that will strengthen disadvantaged communities in Northern Nevada.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
