RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO THE EDDY HOUSE TO SUPPORT THEIR MISSION TO WORK WITH HOMELESS AND ATRISK YOUTH TO DEVELOP LIFE AND JOB SKILLS THAT LEAD TO SUSTAINABLE INDEPENDENCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000. (GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028, entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Eddy House, a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, is a Northern Nevada 24 hour drop-in resource center for Norther Nevada homeless youth aged 12-14 to receive essential services such as overnight shelter, showers, laundry, food, and clothing; and,

WHEREAS, the Eddy House offers youth programs upon admittance focusing on job skills, health relationships, empowerment, life skills, and GED and education engagement; and,

WHEREAS, the Eddy House promotes job acquisition by offering job training through employment services and community-based partnerships that promote skilled trades; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Martinez in the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000) to the Eddy House to support their mission to work with homeless and at-risk youth to develop life and jobs skills that lead to sustainable independence: and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
