ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENO, NEVADA REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 6600 AND REVOKING AUTHORITY TO ISSUE "CITY OF RENO, NEVADA 2021 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2 (STONEGATE I) LOCAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS, SERIES 2021" IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$36,860,000; AND MATTERS WHICH PERTAIN TO OR ARE NECESSAILY CONNECTED THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Reno, Nevada (the "City") adopted Ordinance No. 6596 on second and final reading on June 2, 2021 (the "Creation Ordinance"), creating the "City of Reno, Nevada 2021 Special Assessment District No. 2 (StoneGate I)" (the "District") for the purpose of acquiring and improving a sanitary sewer project and a water project (collectively, the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 6598 on second and final reading on July 21, 2021 (the "Assessment Ordinance"), authorizing the levy of assessments in the amount of \$36,860,000 against the property in the District benefited by the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 6600 on second and final reading on August 11, 2021 authorizing the issuance of its "City of Reno, Nevada 2021 Special Assessment District No. 2 (StoneGate I) Local Improvement Bonds, Series 2021" in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$36,860,000 (the "Bonds") to provide funds to pay the cost and expense of the Project, pay a portion of the interest on the Bonds, fund a reserve fund for the Bonds, and pay certain costs of issuing the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds were never issued pursuant to the request of Heinz Ranch Land Company, LLC, a Nevada limited liability company (the "Developer"); and

WHEREAS, the City has informed the Developer of the termination of the Development and Financing Agreement for 2021 Special Assessment District No. 2 (StoneGate I) dated as of March 11, 2021 between the City and the Developer, pursuant to the terms thereof, and of its intention to repeal the Creation Ordinance, the Assessment Ordinance and Ordinance No. 6600; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to separate ordinances, the Council will repeal the Creation Ordinance and the Assessment Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to repeal, rescind and annul Ordinance No. 6600 in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RENO DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as, and may be cited by, the short title "Ordinance No. 6600 Repealing Ordinance."

- **Section 2.** Repeal of Ordinance No. 6600. The Council does hereby repeal, rescind and annul its Ordinance No. 6600.
- **Section 3.** Ratification of Prior Actions. All actions, proceedings, matters and things heretofore taken, had and done by the Council and the officers of the City (not inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance), concerning the repeal of Ordinance No. 6600 are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
- **Section 4.** Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions, bylaws and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance, resolution, bylaw or order, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.
- **Section 5.** <u>Severability</u>. If any section, paragraph, clause or other provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or other provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 6.** Publication of Proposed Ordinance. When first proposed, this Ordinance shall be read to the Council by title, after which an adequate number of copies of the proposed Ordinance must be filed with the Clerk for public distribution. Notice of the filing shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, at least 10 days before the adoption of this Ordinance, such publication to be in substantially the following form:
