

**RESOLUTION DONATING COUNCIL DISCRETIONARY FUNDS TO  
THE RIVERSIDE FARMERS MARKET IN SUPPORT OF THEIR  
MISSION TO SHOWCASE SMALL, LOCAL, AND SUSTAINABLE  
FARMERS AND RANCHERS WHO BELIEVE THAT HEALTHY FOOD  
BEGINS WITH A HEALTHY LAND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500.  
(GENERAL FUND)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno may donate funds in accordance with NRS 268.028(01), entitled "Expenditure of public money; grant of public money and donation of certain property to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities" when such expenditure provides a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reno recognizes the importance of supporting local businesses, particularly those that promote healthy eating habits and provide access to fresh, locally grown produce; and

**WHEREAS**, the Riverside Farmers Market is a local non-profit farmers market that provides access to fresh, locally grown produce to residents and visitors of the City of Reno; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Reno approves the Council donation from Councilmember Duerr in the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) to the Riverside Farmers Market to be used for student scholarships for their 2023 sustainability expedition; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that should the above donation or any portion thereof not be used for the purpose as set forth in this Resolution, any unused funds shall be returned to the City of Reno.
