







# Cooperative Agreement

- NDOT to perform safety improvements.
- No cost to the City.
- City agrees to maintain.



## FHWA Section 130 Program

- Provides funds for the elimination of hazards at railroad crossings.
- NDOT receives approximately \$1.2M per year.
- 2017 Nevada Hazard Index Model.



#### Additional Selection Factors

- Proximity to the University of Nevada.
- High volume of vulnerable road users.
- Proximity to Dick Taylor Memorial Park.
- Proximity to Evelyn Mount Community Center.



## **Key Safety Improvements**

- Sidewalk connectivity.
- PROWAG compliant features.
- Concrete panel replacement and extensions.
- Drainage improvements.
- Upgraded traffic control devices and circuitry.



### Staff Recommendation

I move to approve the Cooperative Agreement with NDOT to construct railroad at-grade crossing safety improvements on Highland Avenue within the City right-of-way and authorize the Mayor to sign.
