Special Revenue Funds (SRF)

- SRFs are created to account for specific revenue sources that are legally restricted or dedicated
- SRFs are often established to account for government grants, taxes, fees, or other revenue streams
- Provide transparency and accountability in the use of restricted revenues by separating them from other general funds.

One Nevada Opioid Recoveries Funds

- Received \$425K in FY 22/23
- Continue to receive funds for 10+ years
- Restricted for Use Outlined in Exhibit E
