


Two applications to conduct privileged activity at 219 University Way aka Reno City Center

Historical Information (Gaming)


- The property was originally licensed for nonrestricted gaming in 1947
- Gaming use has never been abandoned at the state or local level
 - State Grandfathered from the requirements of NRS 436.1605 and 463.01865 which require a minimum of 301 rooms
 - City Nonconforming use is allowed per RMC Sec. 18.01.403(f)(1) since the use has never been abandoned for more than a year

Physical Location




Located at 219 University Way

Site consist of multiple parcels




Proposed Operation
